What is Included:

The tuition fee above covers all tuition, building, maintenance and IT charges for each child's education. Extracurricular activities, excursions, camps, and uniforms are excluded and will be charged separately.

Lower Income Fee:

To be eligible for the lower income fee, you need to qualify as a low income family. This is determined by your family's gross income and is a \$ value set by the State Government.

In 2021, your family's gross income needs to be below approximately \$60,264 for a family with one school-age child. (The limit will vary depending on how many dependent children you have.)

Proof of income is required and applicants will need to apply via the [State Government's School Card scheme](#).

Our finance manager can help you if you have any questions about applying for the lower income fee.

Need help with School Fees?

If you are concerned about your ability to pay schools fees, we strongly encourage you to have a discussion with us. We believe a family's financial circumstances should not be a barrier to a student accessing a Catholic education.

Payment Methods

Payments can be made in full or by an approved payment plan where we encourage all families to set up weekly, fortnightly or monthly direct debit payments

Payment options include:

- **Direct Deposit** – electronic transfer from your bank account – preferred option.
- **Centrepay** – a deduction from Centrelink payments (It is a family's responsibility to organise this).
- **Cash or Cheque**

Frequency of Payment

You can choose to make your payments upfront in full, weekly, fortnightly, monthly or termly.
