UNIFORM POLICY - 2020

**All children are expected to wear the school uniform.
A note to the class teacher is required if a child is not in uniform.**

Parents are asked to assist teachers with the following:

- Students with shoulder length hair or longer, must have it tied back at all times.
- Hair accessory colours to be only: white, blue, navy, green or brown.
- Jewellery kept to a minimum: earrings to be small plain studs or sleepers, watches & religious items.
- All socks must be plain in colour – no logos.
- Nail polish not to be worn.

Summer Uniform - Girls

Dress: Blue, white, gold check
Skort: Navy with blue school logo shirt
Jumper: School jumper
Socks: Plain navy (mid-calf)
Sandals: Brown or navy
Shoes: Black

Winter Uniform - Girls

Skirt/pinafore: Blue & grey wool blend
Skort: Navy
Shirt: Blue with school logo (unisex)
Jumper: School jumper
Socks/tights: Navy (socks mid-calf or knee)
Shoes: Black
Optional: Plain Navy scarf, beanie, gloves, vest

Summer Uniform - Boys

Shirt: Blue with school logo (unisex)
Shorts: Grey plain school type (**not cargo**)
Jumper: School jumper
Socks: Plain grey (mid calf)
Sandals: Brown or navy
Shoes/boots: Black

Winter Uniform - Boys

Trousers: Grey long school type (**not cargo**)
Shirt: Blue with school logo
Socks: Plain grey (mid calf)
Jumper: School jumper
Shoes/boots: Black
Optional: Plain Navy scarf, beanie, gloves, vest

Sports Uniform – Boys and Girls

Shorts: Navy with school name
Polo shirt: Navy/white with school logo
Socks: Plain white (ankle or mid-calf length)

Track pants: Navy with school name
Jumper: School jumper
Sandshoes

- **PLAIN NAVY** Vests and coats for extra warmth may be worn
- **PLAIN BLACK OR NAVY** Girls sport/active style briefs (bike pants) may be worn under uniform

Uniforms are available from St James School – Wednesday morning between 8.30-9.00am.
